 - Mark 1:14

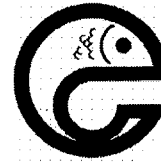

### Lenten Regulations

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of abstinence from meat and also of fast; in other words, limited to a single full meal and two light meals that, together should not equal a full meal. The other Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence from meat. The Church requires all those who are age 14 and older to observe the law of abstinence. All those from age 18 to age 60 are required to observe the law of fast.
