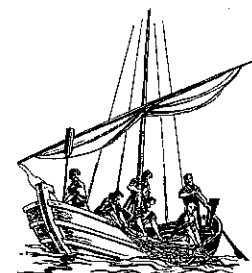

TODAY'S GOSPEL READING



Have you ever thought how Jesus Christ comes to be Lord of all areas of your life? It isn't all at once, is it? On Sundays we give Him our heart and tell Him we want to live for Him, and feel that wonderful peace, knowing that we are loved. But then we go back to work on Monday and the real world hits. We wonder "How

can my faith make any difference in this place?" We know His teachings and believe in His salvation, but how can He actually change my marriage, my family or workplace into a place filled with His love? Well, often, the answer is exactly what Jesus did with Peter in this morning's Gospel: Jesus asks us if he can use our "boat," our boat being whatever we use to get by; to gain security, to protect ourselves. He doesn't start preaching to us, He just enters and quietly asks us to try His path in whatever area we've welcomed Him into. He may ask a simple task of obedience waiting for our "Yes." Because if we agree, as Peter did, we will be amazed at the results with Jesus in our "boats."

Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send?" Do you think that the Lord wants to send you as a as a priest, deacon, sister or brother?

LIFE
