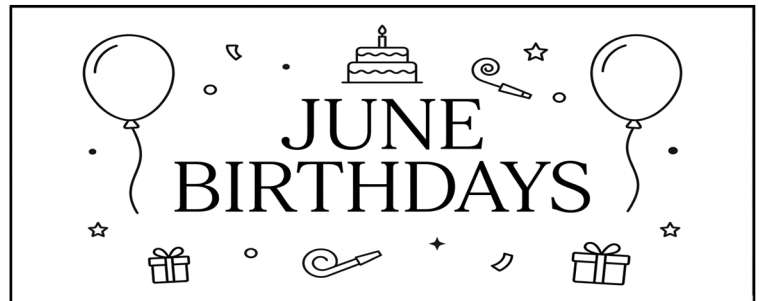


Sign up for Travelling Crucifix for Vocations

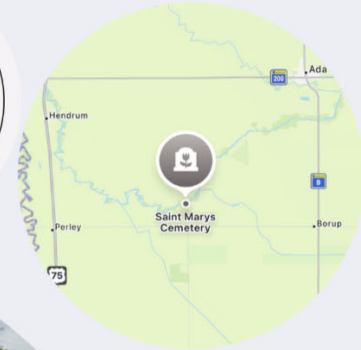
