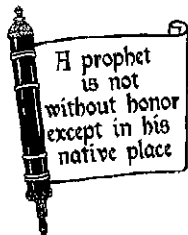
EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION is offered in our parish on Mondays from 4:00 to 7:00 p.m.

What is Reverence ?

It does not take great imagination to understand how the holy angels would be horrified today in some parishes where reverence is lacking. Oh Lord, thank you for the bountiful blessings you have shed on my country:

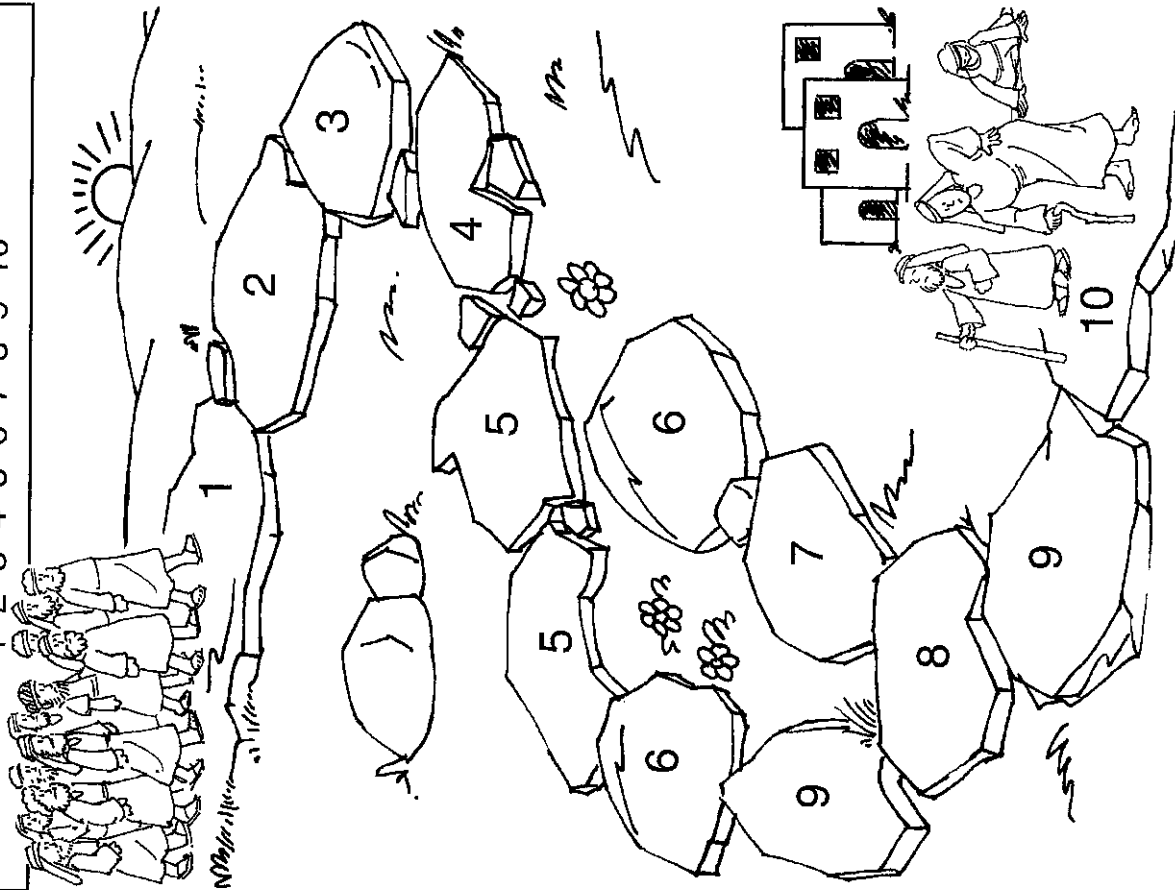
- for freedom that allows us to pursue happiness at our own pace and to worship you at all times

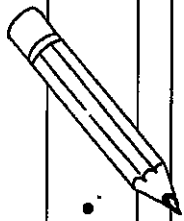

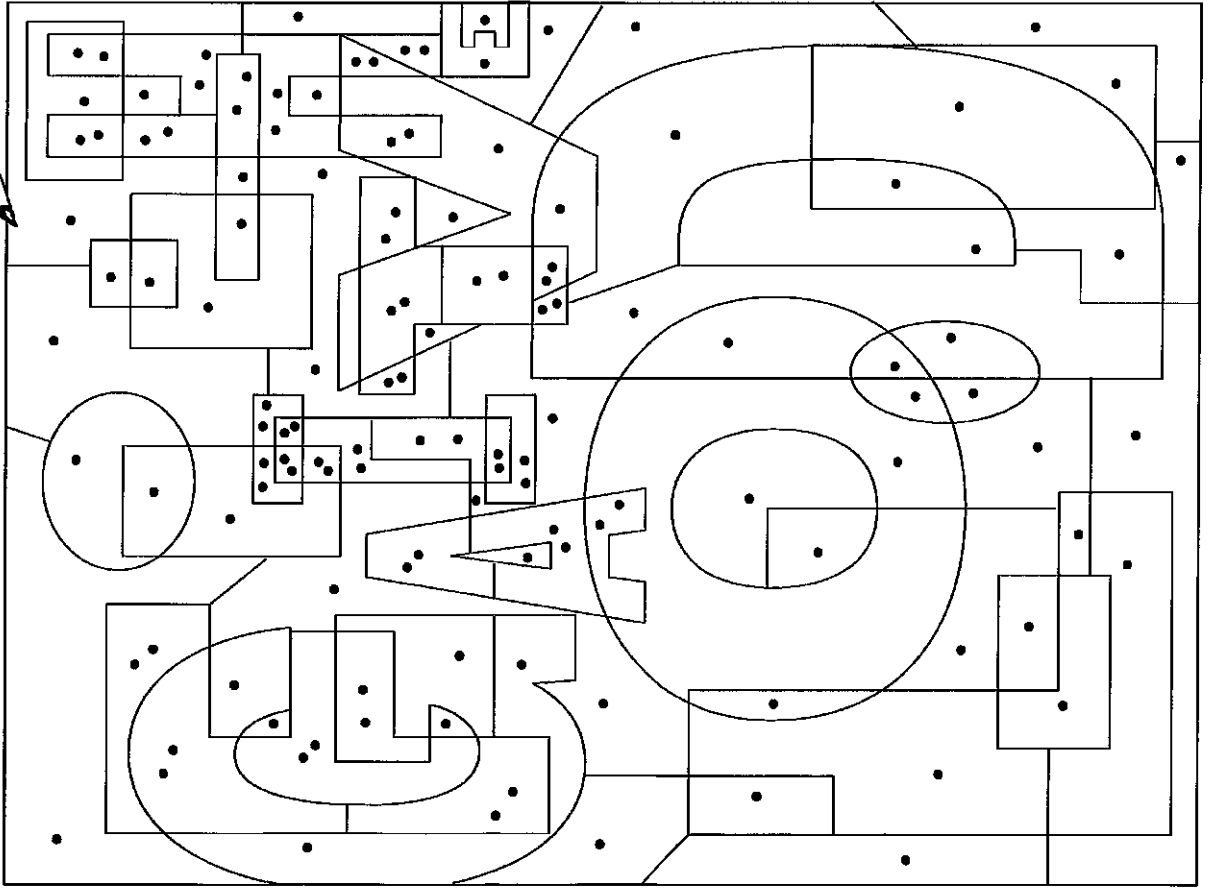
